Emergency Vehicle Technician (EVT)

The Arvada Fire Protection District (AFPD) has an immediate opening for an Emergency Vehicle Technician. This is a full time, FLSA non-exempt, position.

The Emergency Vehicle Technician performs maintenance and repair of automotive, firefighting apparatus and ambulance equipment.

Minimum Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age

- Possess a Fire Apparatus Technician EVT Level 1 certification – or obtain within one (1) year of hire
- Possess Ambulance EVT Level 1 Certification certification – or obtain within one (1) year of hire
- Must be able to drive fire apparatus and other emergency vehicles in order to test drive for diagnosis after repairs or to deliver and pick-up equipment.

- Possess hand tools adequate to perform required tasks

- Possess a Fire Apparatus Technician EVT Level 2 and/or Ambulance EVT Level 2 Certification.
